

Question: What is The Gospel ?

I. The Divine Plan of God:

Genesis 1:26-28 - (The Beginning "Fallen Man")

26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have <u>dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all[b] the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." **27** So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. **28** Then God <u>blessed them</u>, and God said to them, "<u>Be fruitful</u> and <u>multiply</u>; <u>fill the earth</u> and <u>subdue</u> it; <u>have dominion</u> over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth." **29** And God said, "See, <u>I have given</u> you every herb *that* yields seed which *is* on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. **30** Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which *there is* life, *I have given* every green herb for food"; and it was so.

a. Be fruitful

1. To cause something to bear fruit (Parah)

- b. Multiply
 - 1. To increase, become many (Rabah)

c. Fill the earth (spread)

- 1. The garden did not fill the earth
- 2. It was in the east in Eden
- 3. He did not populate it
- 4. The glory of the Lord will fill the earth (we are His image on the earth)

d. Subdue (Kabash)

- 1. Gain authority
- 2. Trample on it
- 3. Force into bondage or submission
- 4. Bring things under our rulership (gaining, conquering)

e. Have Dominion (Radah)

1. Exercise your authority (not gain but use it, carry it out)

f. I have given

- 1. Everyone has a garden
- 2. Given and provided for

Genesis 9:1-8 – (2nd Beginning "Noah")

- a. Fruitful
- b. Multiply
- c. Fill the Earth
- d. Dominion (the fear of you shall be on every "beast")
- e. Authority (they are given to you)
- f. I have given (I have given you all things)





Genesis 17: 1-8 – (3rd Beginning "Abraham")

- a. Be fruitful "Go out from your country" (Parah) (12:1-3)
- b. Multiply
- c. Fill the earth (a father of many nations)
- d. Dominion (kings shall come from you)
- e. Authority (My covenant established in you)
- f. I give (I also give to you and your decedents)

Matthew 28: 18-20 – (4th Beginning "The Church")

- a. Same call given to Fallen man is the same call given to risen man
- b. Beginning with the resurrection (John 15:16)
 - a. I have given (chose for nothing)
 - b. Dominion (Appointed)
 - c. Be Fruitful (That you should "Go")
 - d. Multiply (Bear Fruit)
 - e. Fill The Earth (your fruit should remain)
 - f. Authority (Whatever you ask)

Matthew 28: 18-20:

- a. Be fruitful (Go -Parah)
- b. Multiply (Make disciples)
- c. Fill the earth (of all nations)
- d. Dominion (Teach them, exercise your authority)
- e. Authority ("Lo, I am with you)
- f. I give (The Holy Spirit) "Lo, I am with you always)

Question: Why are we not experiencing The Acts experience ? Miracles, signs and wonders ?

II. Faith & Repentance (They work together)

Periodically we need to update our Faith

John 14:21 (NKJV)

21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

Ezekiel 8:6

6 Furthermore He said to me, "Son of man, do you see what they are doing, the great abominations that the house of Israel commits here, to make Me go far away from My sanctuary?

- Sin put's God at a distance. Sin does not allow God to dwell with us.
- Sin trades out authority

III. The Gospel

Luke 4:16-21 (NKJV)

16 So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. 17 And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: 18 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me,

because He has anointed Me

To preach the gospel to the poor;

He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,

To proclaim liberty to the <u>captives</u>

And recovery of sight to the blind,

To set at liberty those who are <u>oppressed;</u>

19 To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

20 Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. **21** And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

- Save your souls
- Heal your minds
- Penetrate the darkness in your life
- Set you at liberty (free them)
- He will proclaim the acceptable year of The Lord in your life (debts are forgiven, slaves are set free) Rest
- God's Kingdom is arriving and it's arriving in me (My person) (Christ Authority) (IN ME) and
- I'm giving you the keys to do the same as I am doing

Get back:

- your fruitfulness
- your ability to increase
- your authority
- your eternity
- your dominion

God has GIVEN this to you

This is The Full Gospel. The Gospel is THE FULL RECOVERY OF EVERYTHING THAT WAS LOST

- He will move you from one Kingdom to another. It is MORE than just going to Heaven ... There is a whole Kingdom that God wants to give us.
- It's MORE than forgiving your sins. It's setting you completely free from every debt (generational curses, statistics, education, calculations, evidence) It's cancelled!
